

# Canadian Minority Media Database

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Created in 2012, the Canadian Minority Media Database (CMMD) is the first online resource entirely devoted to minority media operated in Canada. The CMMD hosts currently more than 650 entries. The student will be responsible for updating the database, adding new entries, promoting the CMMD, and increasing its visibility on social media (e.g., Facebook).
