

Chinese Economy

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

"The focus of the research internship would be the economy of China. The specific topic could be Chinese finance, Chinese foreign trade, Chinese finance, FDI (both inward-bound and outward-bound) or Chinese resource economics.

It would be the expectation of the China Institute that the intern would use the facilities of the China Institute and through interaction between the supervisor and other researchers at the Institute to advance their understanding of a key dimension of the Chinese economy, and to assist the work of the China Institute on economic issues related to China.

The successful intern(s) would be encouraged (but not required) to publish the work undertaken at the China Institute, either through external journals, or through an "occasional paper" published by the China Institute.
